# Introduction

#### **ACB Framework**

- Hyun-A provided a quick overview of the original NCHRP 20-24(95) project which created the ACB framework.
- The ACB COP has been developed as part of NCHRP Project 20-44(40): Implementing the Agency Capacity Building Framework to Activate Organizational Change. The COP members will help to update the framework.

## **ACB Community of Practice**

- Lori highlighted the ACB Portal, the ACB Guide and the role of the COP.
- Additional capabilities will be developed based on feedback from the COP.



- Lori provided a live demo of the COP pages on the portal. Lori asked for input on whether to add contact information to the COP membership list on the portal. Commenters on the chat indicated it would be good to add email addresses.
- The blog will be moderated by SPP.

- Victoria suggested quick video clips about how to use the ACB tools. She recommended the book Smart Brevity.
- Gary recommended getting feedback from users at in-person meetings (booths at TRB, AASHTO meetings).
- Amanda reviewed the planned stakeholder engagement (COP, Agency interviews, Peer exchanges, pilots, and workshops).
- David mentioned the importance of marketing tools (especially for leadership and key groups).
- Christos asked how the ACB portal will be supported in the future. It will be through the AASHTO Committee on Performance-Based Management.
